Our team had the first meeting on 16th October 2019 at Real Estate's Studio, Faculty of Built Environment. We brainstormed and did some online research in order to construct a solid and secure structure of see-saw. We gathered ideas from length of the see-saw till the completion of the product and all the materials needed. As we also had a limited knowledge in design and constructing, we asked some opinions from building surveyor's and architecture's students on our ideas and precautions to take in making this component.

On the next day, we had our second meeting to create a prototype of the seesaw. It took up only one day for us to complete the prototype. After all the materials needed arrived, we spent two days to construct the see-saw. On the first day, we sanding and preparing the woods to ensure the length and width and smoothing the surface from any sharp materials that would cause injuries. After that, we painted the see-saw plank colorfully to make it looks nicer and more attractive for the kids. We let it dry for one day.

On the second day, we continue with the see-saw axle and the base, after that, we assemble all the parts with the see-saw plank.

On the event day, the completed see-saw is moved together with other components from our faculty's workshop to the site. There, we had a breakfast before we started to clear the bushes on the site. After that, we proceed with digging three holes to install the base (semen foundation) and tyres to bounce the plank ups and downs for both sides. We first poured the concrete before installing the see-saw to get a strong and secure structure so it is safely used by the kids. As the see-saw was completely installed and the concrete dried, we tested the see-saw's stability by sitting on both sides of the see-saw's plank.

Hence, this project is considered success as we achieved the objectives. The whole team did a great team works during implementation day. Even though it was a long tiring day, it was all worth after all. We are thankful for everyone's cooperation to get involved all the way to the end of this program.

For the social engagement project, we were assigned tasks to build the scaffolding maze as item to be included in the playground. We had to buy the materials to prepare for the prototype which was to be presented on the pre-event program, which was called *Program Pemindahan Ilmu – Kebun-kebun Sentosa*, which was to be held on 29th September 2019 in Taman Sri Sentosa to promote our project. On the 26rd September 2019, our group had a meeting in the Faculty of Built Environment to complete the prototype and prepare the materials for a mini exhibition booth

After the program, we spent time after our class for two day to paint & spray the scaffolding time which were not in use and stored at our faculty workshop nearby. We managed to clean and spray the scaffoldings with white colour base. On the day '*Jom Turun Padang Membina Kebun-kebun Sentosa*', the scaffolding was delivered from our faculty to the site in Taman Sri Sentosa for installation at the site. The initial plan to put up the 'scaffolding maze' was canceled after experimenting a few times on the soil which were not suitable/hard for digging work. Therefore, we changed to build up 'fence' parameter around the playground that we build. There were 10 scaffolding used for the purpose. After a hole was dig on the ground, the cement (concrete) is poured into the hole to shape and fix the standing scaffolding. The 'scaffolding fence was fully installed and painted (blue) to be properly presented to the community – a playground made from reused items.

Before

When we entered third year, there is a subject that is compulsory for everyone to take. The subject is called Social Engagement (GIG1005/GXEX1417). Everyone in the class was divided into several groups which each group will be assigned with varieties of tasks. My group was responsible in making a maze for our playground. We started on our task on 29th of October 2019 which was to spray the scaffolding at the workshop nearby our faculty. The whole process was being monitored by one of the staff who is working at the workshop. After

Before

From the beginning until the end, we were guided by Dr. Zafirah Al Sadat Binti Zyed to propose our project 'Program Jom Turun Padang: Membina Kebun-Kebun Sentosa'. We did the early paperwork required after Dr. Zafirah explained to us about this project in detail. The details discussed were mainly about the construction on D-Day and the plan for Open Day which was held a few weeks before D-Day. As there were some extra sand and stones, we poured it on the damaged ground at our project site so that the surface is flatter to prevent children from falling when they play at the playground.
