





#### **TIMELINE**



#### **ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION**

#### 1. STORY TELLING

This exciting online activity suits well with preschoolers as it develops and familiarizes their young mind on English language. The duration of the storytelling may be in between 2-4 minutes per entry as we know the ESL learners in preschool do not have a wide vocabulary on English yet and might struggle too much with a longer duration of storytelling. Furthermore, this activity is highly engaging as the choice of topic is open and may revolve on what the children want to talk about such as their pets, their favourite toys or even their best friend. The objective of this activity is to expose preschoolers in using English as a medium to express themselves. The participants will be judged based on their content, speech delivery, pronunciation and intonation of storytelling.

#### 2. STORY CONTINUATION

This online activity targets ESL learners in primary school and requires students to be creative as they are given a short phrase such as "I woke up this morning and found out...." and have them continue the story until the end. The duration of the story continuation may be in between 3-5 minutes per entry as it is not too short and not too long for a story continuation. This activity is suitable for primary school students as they should have the basic of English language and are able to write and experiment with lots of words they know, using their own idea on how they want the story to continue. The children aged 7-12 years old would find this activity interesting as they have the power to end the story according to their own imagination. Thus, they would be engaged to participate and subconsciously learn while they take part in this activity. Lastly, the objective of this activity is to help the primary students to experiment and have confidence in using English language. The participants will be judged based on their content, speech delivery, pronunciation and intonation of story continuation.

#### 3. PUBLIC SPEAKING

This challenging yet beneficial online activity is perfect for ESL learners in secondary school who are already familiar with English language and are basically able to use the language whenever they want to. The students will have to record their public speaking within the duration of 5-7 minutes per entry and with the topic having to relate with the current issues happening in Malaysia or global issues which are affecting Malaysia such as the pandemic, Covid-19. By participating in this activity, students can boost their confidence when they deliver their speech, and develop critical thinking skills when they elaborate and give further enlightenment on the topic they have chosen thus greatly improve their communication skills using English language. The participants will be judged based on their content, speech delivery, pronunciation and intonation of public speaking.

#### **ATTACHMENT 4 ; ISSUES/CHALLENGES**

The most prominent issue or challenge in conducting this "Once Upon A Quarantime" competition would be communication. Since everything is conducted online, we had to do our online discussions and meetings through Whatsapp which can be quite inconvenient because there were a few people who might not really be present during the meeting. Sometimes, it could take us days to get the opinions of others and to finally agree on something.

Another issue that we faced is in handling the participants' parents. After we announced the winners, there were some parents who actually came and kind of attacked us for not choosing the right "winners". Some even commented on how they think that some of the winners are not worthy of winning. Moreover, we also had trouble in getting their information. Most of them did not trust our committee members who asked for their contact numbers and bank account information. This has been quite stressful for us because we wanted to settle everything regarding their e-certificates and cash prizes as soon as possible. However, since some of them did not even bother to reply, this has somehow slowed down our work.

Due to the parents' refusal to trust and reply to us, this has doubled the work for the Media & Publicity team as they had to come up with new posters and post them on our Facebook and Instagram pages in order to remind the parents and participants that they have to give full cooperation.

#### **ATTACHMENT 5 ; ACHIEVEMENTS**

We have achieved our main objective of the activity which is to introduce various interesting activities as a way of learning the English language in a more interactive way. To explain further, each category of participants were assigned different tasks such as a simple story-telling for preschool, story-continuation for primary level students, and public speaking for secondary level students. Each task was constructed carefully based on the expected proficiency of students in each category and can show students that the English language is not all about learning the rules and grammar, but can be learned when delivering a story they are passionate about. This achievement can be seen in the number of participants (115 participants) taking part in the competition, alongside their effort and excited faces shown in their videos.

Our next objective which is to promote the English language as one of the most important and intriguing core subjects to learn in the school syllabus was successful. Learning English is also about using the language daily. This competition gave an exposure to the participants on the use of English as Malaysia's second language and may spark the participants' curiosity in learning more about the English language.


The third objective of this event, which is to encourage students to communicate in the English language and overcome their lack of confidence while doing so, is achieved as well. Our tasks for each respective category require them to speak in the English language to convey their stories and ideas from an age as early as 5 years old. Since English is our country's second language, we understand that most students do not speak English at home hence, they might lack confidence in speaking English. However, based on the videos of the participants, we can conclude that the participants look very confident when delivering their stories and speaking fluently in English, albeit not accurate.

We also managed to infuse students with higher-order thinking and problem-solving skills efficiently throughout their involvement in the activities. To elaborate, our task for preschool level participants requires them to use the English language to talk about something they love such as their pets which expose them to the structures of the English language as beginner-level proficiency students. Meanwhile, primary level students were required to come up with a story continuation in which they have to brainstorm and think about where to lead their stories according to the first few sentences provided by us. Lastly, the secondary level students were required to present a public speaking on topics regarding current issues in Malaysia, which trains students to think critically and use their problem-solving skills when talking about the issues in our country. This achievement can be seen through the content of the participants' storytelling and public speaking in their videos.

#### ENHANCING ENGLISH DURING HARSH TIMES

Seventy-eight Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL) students from University Malaya recently organized an online storytelling competition during the prior Movement Control Order (MCO) period as part of their Social Engagement subject, a compulsory university course.

Determined to show that being stuck at home should not be a deterrent to continue learning and polishing the English language, the TESL students conducted this event throughout the entire month of May 2020 to provide a fun and motivating platform for school students to practice and refine their English despite the Covid-19 pandemic.

titled "Once Upon project, Quarantime" to pun the country-wide lockdown, was an online competition designed for Malaysian students to showcase their storytelling talents during the Movement Control Order (MCO). The competition was divided into three categories: pre-school, primary school and secondary school. **Participants** required to record a video of themselves recounting their stories within a given time limit based on the topic assigned for



each category, and then upload their recordings on either Instagram TV or Facebook. Winners of the competition from each category were awarded with cash prizes: RM200 for the 1<sup>st</sup> places, RM150 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> places, and RM100 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> places. Physical certificates were also provided for every participant as a symbol of their courageous involvement and achievement in taking part in the competition.

One of the program directors, Elyshia Abigail A/K Bonny, 24, stated: "The aim of the project was to help students build confidence and to practice their English language despite being away from school."

The storytelling videos were not merely judged based on how interesting the stories were. Instead, participants were required to take into account their pronunciation, intonation, language use, flow, and creativity; when combined, those are difficult feats to refine. One of the rules set for the competition was for the video to be a one-take video as it was vital to review aspects such as students' fluidity, stuttering, confidence, and so on. Therefore, the one-month duration for submissions worked to encourage students to continuously practice perfecting their speeches.

Program director Hariez Pishal, 21, said: "We ran this competition in hopes of giving students of all ages something worthwhile to do during the MCO regarding their English skills. As TESL students, we can attest that speaking to an unlimited amount of online

audiences is not something easy, therefore we also wanted to properly reward participants for gaining the courage to practice and showcase their public speaking skills for the world to see."

The event proved to be of value to many participants, most notably the winners, who each had their own reasons to speak out online. Other than that, many discoveries were also made on the journey to submit their speeches.

"My awareness towards current issues in our country has increased vividly. Through these types of competitions, I realised that there is more to life than just playing games or hanging out with friends. I found out that by voicing my thoughts out, I could actually help bring light to unfortunate circumstances. I feel happy and relieved knowing that I can play a part in helping people through my speaking," claimed participant Nur Amani Binti Md. Noordin, the first-place winner for the Upper Secondary category.

Similarly, Ryan Choo, the first runner up for the Upper Secondary category, vouched for the same reasoning, saying: "I chose my topic about our society because I've faced quite a lot of personal difficulties and it made me want to share my experience to others in case it could help anybody at all. In terms of my experience on the competition itself, I found that it really helped me determine how unprepared I truly am in preparing the script, memorising it and presenting. Throughout my practice, I realised that it really motivated me to improve my thinking skills as well as vocal skills."

Media and Publicity Head Ria binti Rosman, 21, voiced: "As a future educator, I realised that even without the pandemic, students rarely have healthy, competitive, physical platforms to refine their speaking skills to voice out their opinions regarding topics of their choices. Now, along with the addition of the current pandemic taking away a lot of probable experience from students, we hoped that the event could act as a fun stepping stone for students to better enhance their speaking skills, as well as encourage them to recognize English as a medium for creative expressions beyond just academic learning."

"It was such a pleasant surprise to receive so many submissions, with an abundant of different and imaginative storylines and content. It was enthralling to see how passionate the students can get when they are given the freedom to speak out about what they believe in, and I am sure this competition helped spark their confidence to begin speaking more in their futures," mentioned Secretary Izzah Fatini Binti Dzulkifli, 21.

Even with all the positive execution response, the competition was not successfully completed without some minor bumps on the road.

Assistant director, Nur Farhah Nadhirah Binti Mohd Suhaimi, 20, shared: "It was challenging

as we were not able to hold physical meetings in order to ask for other members' opinions and take on the progress. The pandemic forced us to carry out only online meetings, which sometimes were unfortunate due to some members facing poor connectivity and having different schedules. We commonly ran into incidences that required instant fixing but due to our separation, it was tough to properly discuss and understand different point-of-views and suggestions."

Despite the minor setbacks, the future educators learned valuable lessons through carrying out this event nonetheless.

Director Elyshia Abigail said: "Because we conducted this event during the pandemic, we had to constantly face challenges regarding time management and meeting difficulties. Whenever we came across a problem, it was tough because we needed to solve things immediately but we were not physically around each other to discuss. Despite that, we were all very determined to pull off the event and kept each other updated and on our toes through online platforms and meetings."

"In the end, we all realized the importance of our roles and how we needed to work together to ensure the success of the competition. I was proud to see how my project members worked fluidly as a team and put in so much effort in each of their tasks despite not being able to meet physically. Our joint determination was one of the main reasons why this project was eventually a successful one."

Director Hariez added: "I believe the experience we received from hosting this competition is extremely valuable and will definitely aid in our conquests to become future educators. It makes me glad to know that as trainees, we provided some Malaysian students the opportunity to make their home-restrained lives during the MCO a little more beneficial

Dr. Fatiha Senom, Senior Lecturer and advisor for the TESL students, finished off by remarking: "Through this project, the 'Once Upon A Quarantime' undergraduates have learned the importance of social engagement, to work and collaborate in groups and with the community, and exercise to good communication skills with the community, especially with the school students who took part in the competition as well as their parents. As the course coordinator for this project, I am very proud of them."
